



2026 Coca Cola Junior Men's Lobstick Rule Sheet



Rules of Play: All Play is governed by the Rules of Golf and Decisions established by Golf Canada

Teeing Ground:

- Qualifying & Match Play – **White Tees**

Rules:

1. **Caddies** – Competitors **are not permitted** the use of a caddie
2. **Summer Rules** – are in effect; Play the ball as it lies throughout the golf course.
3. **Ground Under Repair** – all ground under repair will be marked with white paint.
4. **Second Ball Rule**- If in doubt as to correct procedure: • Announce which ball you wish to score with • Play a second ball, holing both balls out • Count strokes with each ball. • Ask the rules committee for a ruling before signing your score card.
5. **Hole #10 Snack Shack** area (marked by white paint) is an **immovable obstruction**. Players may take **FREE RELIEF** in the designated drop area.
6. **Hole #18 Water Pond** – Local rule **IS NOT** in affect – rocks are apart of the penalty area.
7. **Penalty Areas** – will be marked with red paint – hole #6, #13, #18.
8. **Trees and Wood Chips Piled for Removal** are deemed to be an **abnormal ground condition**. Players may take **FREE RELIEF** from stance or swing, but not line of intended play.
9. **Bunkers** – You may smooth out and place your ball in the bunker at the nearest point of original lie.
10. **Bear** – The bear is deemed to be a dangerous animal by Rule 6.2. A player may take **FREE RELIEF** at the nearest point not nearer (not nearer the hole) where the dangerous animal condition does not exist.
11. **Slow Play** – is strongly discouraged. Please play **Ready Golf**. Your position on the golf course is within one hole of the group ahead. Rule 5.6a in relation to unreasonable delay of play is in effect.
12. **Fix all Ball Marks & Replace Divots**. Failure to do so may result in **disqualification**.
