

2021 Lobstick COVID-19 Guidelines & Protocols

The Waskesiu Golf Course and Lobstick Championship Committee share the concerns about COVID-19 pandemic and its impact on everyday life. The health and wellness of all participants, staff and volunteers as well as our small community is of high priority.

General Protocol

1. Any player experiencing any of the following COVID-19 symptoms within 14 days of the championship start dates is asked to withdraw from the event
 - coughing, shortness of breath or two of the following: fever, chills, shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell
 - a full refund will be issued if a player answers YES to any of those questions
2. You have been in contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days
3. You have travelled outside of the country and returned to Canada within the last 14 days

Local Protocol and General Rules

-The flagstick must remain in the hole at all times. Do not touch the flagstick

-Bunkers. You may smooth out sand and **PLACE** your ball in the bunker and play from that spot

-There will be no official banquets or socials during any of the Lobstick events. The event will be operated under the Provincial COVID-19 Golf Course Guidelines utilizing a minimum of 10 minute tee times.

-Do not arrive more than **20 minutes** before your scheduled tee time.

-Please do not gather at any of the holes once play is completed. Immediately return your cart/pull cart. The Clubhouse will be open should you want to visit for food or drinks, however, the Clubhouse will be following all Provincial Health Guidelines as well.

-There will be no official in person gatherings (banquets/awards). We will not be using shotgun starts.

-Power Carts may not enter the parking lot at any time. We have a sanitization area to drop carts off

-Maintain social distancing at all areas of the course, including the practice facilities

-All rules and regulations will be emailed and posted outside the pro shop & starter shack. There will be **no paper handouts** except the scorecard

-One player will be given the scorecard for all four players.

We ask that all players/caddies respect and adhere to all policies implemented throughout this document as well as follow all signage in and around all facilities
