

Junior Lobstick

Format

The Junior Lobstick is not divided into age groups. Each player is flighted based on qualifying score

Started in 1956, the Junior Lobstick consists of 1 qualifying **medal** round on Monday, followed by **match play**.

Qualifying draw is formatted in a way that players will qualify with players of their own skill level. After qualifying, players will be put into **flights** of 16 players based on what score they shoot.

Match play begins on Tuesday. If a player wins their match on Tuesday, they stay on the "A" side of the draw and play again on Wednesday. If a player loses the first match on Tuesday, they will be dropped down to the "consolation" side of their flight, and will play against the other match loser on Wednesday.

Should a player lose their match on Wednesday, they are eliminated from the tournament, regardless of what side of the draw (A or consolation). Players are only guaranteed 3 rounds.

All winners of Wednesday matches will play again on Thursday in the semifinals. Again, all players that lose, will be eliminated. Winning players move on to the Flight & Consolation Flight Finals on Friday.
